
When weather permits this spring, new landscaping will grace the outer areas of the clubhouse.

The Evolution of Breezy Point Resort, Part 15

We receive requests from readers for more in-depth article about the early days of the Resort. The following stories about water and famous guests are in response to those requests.



Resort logo. Often mistaken for the city's tower, it's similar to thousands that dot the landscape in small towns across America.

This one is very different.

Resort taxed the system of water wells to its breaking point. Feeding the fresh water appetites of the Lodge, hotel, cabins, laundry and other supbuildings port was momentous task, compounded by frequent breakdowns of the numerous pumps and pressure tanks.

In 1930, Fawcett set about to modernize the water system. He con-

tracted with a Twin Cities firm to design and build a

Locals who visited the site daily to view the progress were unsure what to make of the structure. In addition to the familiar tank on top, a second, smaller tank was taking shape beneath it.

The upper tank had a capacity of 50,000 gallons. Its water was drawn from Pelican Lake and was used for irrigation and fire control. The lower tank, with a capacity of 20,000 gallons, was fed by a well and supplied the Resort's drinking and washing water.

The project was completed in late June and a small

crowd of locals and employees gathered to watch Captain Billy turn on the water.

The lower tank was removed in the mid-60s.

The tower today serves needs of the Resort's Conference Center. Marina II & Dockside Lounge complex, Breezy Center, High Village, laundry, the cabins on Fawcett Hill and the hydrant system.

The tower stands 85 feet tall and is home to satellite dishes owned by Sprint and T-Mobile.

As one approaches the Breezy Point Resort gates from the west on County Rd.11, the eye is drawn upward to the deep blue water tower with the Whitebirch. centralized water system that would serve the fresh water needs of the Resort and eliminate the existing network of wells and pumps.

The project included not only a new water tower but also all new water lines to feed each of the Resort's structures.

Steel workers from Detroit and Chicago assembled the tower parts on the ground and each completed section was lifted by cranes for installation on the tower platform.



Famous Guests

Fawcett's early success with Captain Billy's Whiz Bang was the foundation for his publishing empire, Fawcett Publications. He recognized that the risque writings in his Whiz Bang magazine limited his readership to young men.

He had the foresight to create new magazines that would attract mainstream readership, particularly female, and focused his attention on the burgeoning movie industry.



"Talkies" were replacing the silent movies and the fame of movie stars who could actually be heard was the talk of the day.

The movie industry itself was a closely-knit group but Fawcett catered to the stars to get the inside stories for his new magazines, Movie Story and Motion Picture.

Rubbing elbows with the stars gave Fawcett the stories he needed although some of the sensational "scoops" were fabrications of the stars' publicists.

Fawcett's flamboyant personality and enthusiasm resulted in his making of his celebrity guests. They would arrive in Pequot Lakes in a private railway car which would be parked on a siding until their departure.




The road between Pequot Lakes and the Resort was poor at best so Fawcett paid to have it paved.


Although Fawcett was not a gambler, he had for his guests an elaborate casino. It had two roulette wheels, craps tables, poker tables and slot machines.

Prohibition was the law of the land until December of 1933. It did not however, prevent the Resort from serving alcohol to its guests. Some efforts by local law enforcement were taken to shut down illegal liquor operations

but they were sporadic and ineffective at best.

Breezy Point Resort has had a number of good ideas over the past 90 years. Captain Billy Fawcett saw great potential on beautiful Pelican Lake and had the good idea to build a resort to entertain his family and celebrity friends.

Forty years later Ginny Simms and Don Eastvold had a good idea and built the first condominiums in

Minnesota. After that, the Resort thought it was a good idea to build 750 deeded "condominium campsites".

In 1981 the brilliant idea of developing a timeshare project, another first in Minnesota, took flight. The Resort designed, built, sold and manages timeshare units for about 12,000 owners. These owners pay real estate taxes on their units and provide many jobs in the surrounding area.

Then the Resort had a controversial idea and built a new 18-hole golf course, calling it "Whitebirch Championship Golf Course".

The next good idea was the Resort's construction and operation of the

Point Hockey Breezy Center which, through its winter hockey tournament schedule and the summer hockey and figure skating camps, brings over 10,000 visitors to our area. The Arena is also home to the Breezy Point North Stars, the NAHL hockey franchise acquired by the Resort in 2012.

The most recent good idea was the acquisition of the Arnold Palmer designed Deacon's Lodge Golf Course. This addition to the Traditional and Whitebirch courses makes the Resort a true golf destination.

The best idea of all most likely hasn't been thought of yet but we're working on it.

Where Do Wishes Go?

We're often asked where all the coins from the fountains in the lobby and Marina II go. The answer is perhaps most unexpected but we think a very worthy cause.

The proceeds go to Spring Point Project, a charitable organization that is working towards a cure for Type 1 diabetes.

Founded in Minnesota in 2004, Spring Point Project was born out of the passion of Duluth businessman Tom Cartier to find a cure for his son, Cory, whose quality of life was stolen from him at age 10 when he was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes.

When Tom learned of his son's diagnosis in 1993, he went on a mission to find a cure for Type 1 diabetes to improve the life of his son and the tens of to Type 1 diabetes and

thousands of people afflicted with this disease.

Simultaneously a physician, Bernhard Hering, MD, theorized that pig islets could help people with diabetes - pig tissue had been widely used to treat humans with other chronic diseases.

Dr. Hering began work with the Schulze Diabetes Institute at the University of Minnesota to develop his concept that could eventually move pig islet transplantation from vision to practice.

The combined vision and passion of Tom Cartier and Dr. Hering gave birth to Spring Point Project whose mission is to produce the unique 'medical grade' pig resource medical research needs to replace the cells lost due

other conditions.

Today, Spring Point Project works with Dr. Hering and other researchers on similar paths to provide the specialized pig cells needed to cure Type 1 diabetes and other conditions - such as acute and chronic liver failure - that can be cured by replacement of lost cells.

Breezy Point Resort has been a supporter of Spring Point Project since its inception. and continues to stand behind this noble effort by, among other things, passing your wishes along!

Timeshare From Our Perspective

Association Management

Breezy Point Resort introduced timesharing, often referred to as vacation ownership, to Minnesota in 1981 and remains the largest timeshare developer with nearly 12,000 timeshare owners.

Timesharing has been instrumental in the continual growth of the Resort and the surrounding communities and has provided much needed year-round employment.

The timeshare industry has flourished under the watchful eyes of the regulatory agencies and the elected directors. To further protect the interests of the individual timeshare owners, each association has an elected board of directors whose responsibility is to manage the financial and physical health of the association's properties.

The position of director on a timeshare association board is sometimes a thankless job. It carries with it a fiduciary responsibility to entire ownership base.

The board's actions must be totally transparent and dedicated to a constant

effort to hold down the maintenance and administrative costs involved in the association's operations.

In recent years the escalating costs associated with managing timeshare association's properties have increased to the point that some owners are questioning their board's ability to rationally explain the reason for the increases. Other owners are questioning whether term limits for board directors would be a benefit in managing this situation.


Breezy Point Resort, in its association timeshare management role, has successfully kept its fees lower than its competitors and, at the same time, maintained the RCI Gold Crown status.



In all cases, the owner is being told that they must pay up-front fees as high as \$5000 for services, closing costs or other fees. Once the money is received these companies often disappear.

Adding insult to injury, after the company gets the money from the owner they take no action to sell, buy or rent the owner's week or relieve the owner of the ongoing responsibility for association fees.


