North Star Center Medical Clinic & Pharmacy Open



Whiteb Birch, Inc., parent company of Breezy Point Resort, has completed phase 1 of its North Star Center development.

Located on 20 acres on the corner of County Road 11 and Ranchette Drive in Breezy Point, the initial tenants in the 10,000 square foot facility are the CRMC Medical Clinic and GuidePoint Pharmacy.

The medical clinic and pharmacy address is 30833 North Star Drive, just across County Road 11 from the Breezy Point Hockey Center.

The medical clinic is the anchor of the new North Star Center com-

plex. Still on the drawing board is the addition of medical services such as dental and physical therapy.

The population growth and demographics of the City of Breezy Point and surrounding area identified a need for convenient, nearby medical services.

Bob Spizzo, Whiteb Birch CEO said, "Recognizing the growth of the City of Breezy Point and the increasing necessities for our residents and visitors, we saw this opportunity as an ideal fit. The property is perfectly suited for not only the medical needs of the community, but also the future development of ancillary businesses."

Medical Clinic

Services immediately available at the new clinic will include laboratory and diagnostic imaging. Specialty surgery and orthopedic services will also be available. Future services planned include obstetrics/gynecology and reflux and heartburn.

The Breezy Point clinic

is part of CRMC's commitment to bring convenient, comprehensive care to neighborhoods throughout the Brainerd Lakes. With four clinic locations throughout the area, CRMC has the doctor you need, whether it's a primary care doctor to manage your family's health or top-rated specialists who have the experience and expertise to treat more complex health problems.

"As the Brainerd Lakes grows and expands, our goal is to expand with the community so we can be close to home for all your family's health care needs," says Kyle Bauer, CRMC CEO.

The \$3 million, 10,000 square-foot facility includes nine exam rooms, a procedure room, laboratory, X-ray room, central nurses station, registration and welcoming patient area.

Over 16 qualified staff will be employed at the clinic which has additional space available for expansion.

The new clinic, like all CRMC clinics, is connected to the MyChart electronic health record system, so all patients' vital medical information is available to any of the CRMC providers.

Dr. Mark Berntson, a Board-Certified family physician with 30 years' experience, is leading the medical staff which also includes two Advanced Practice Nurse Practitioners, laboratory technologists, phlebotomists, diagnostic imaging technicians, nurses and receptionists.

Grand Forks, North Dakota, where he worked for Sanford Health for 11 years. He also practiced at Altru Health System and the Grand Forks Clinic in North Dakota, and North Valley Family Medicine Clinic, MeritCare, and Falls Clinic in Minnesota.

He is a member of the American Medical Association, American Academy of Family Physicians, Minnesota Academy of Family Physicians and North Dakota Academy of Family Physicians.

Timeshare Owners Beware

Timeshare owners *If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!*

Should you have ques- tions regarding compa- nies that have solicited your timeshare owner- ship, you are urged to contact the Resort at 218- 562-7155.

In all cases, the own- ers are being told that they must pay upfront fees as high as \$5000. Once the money is re- ceived these companies often disappear.

The following are tips to protect yourself:

Be wary of up-front fees.

Don't agree to any- thing before researching the company.

Demand everything in writing.

If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!

Should you have ques- tions regarding compa- nies that have solicited your timeshare owner- ship, you are urged to contact the Resort at 218- 562-7155.

Actions of the associa- tion boards of directors that are not complying with their fiduciary re- sponsibilities to their timeshare owners may also be a concern. If you are not permitted to see the detailed financial rec- ords of your association, this is a red flag worthy of reporting to the State of Minnesota.

Who Preps the Ice ?

Although it's not real- ly a "miracle on ice", the precision work involved in preparing the ice at the Breezy Point Hockey Cen- ter for hockey and figure skating entails man and machine. The machine is the Zamboni, a precision piece of equipment dating back to Frank Zamboni's 1949 invention.

Over the years many improvements were made to the machine and today the Zamboni brand is the number one seller in its field. At a cost of around \$100,000, its an indis- pensable part of an ice rink's perfection. The following are a few Zamboni facts:

At approximately 3/4 of a mile per resurfacing, if there are four resurfac- ings per game, the ma- chines travel an average of three miles during each hockey game.

On average, a Zamboni machine "travels" close to 2,000 miles each year in the course of resurfac- ing.

Over 10,000 Zamboni machines have been de- livered around the world. Prior to the invention of the Zamboni machine, the manual resurfacing of the ice sheet required three or four workers and took over one hour to complete.

Machine No. 4 is in the US Hockey Hall of Fame in Eveleth, MN. When the machine resurfaces the ice, it is capable of removing close to 2,500 pounds of com- pacted snow, while it can leave behind about 1,500 pounds of water.

When Minnesota re- gained its NHL hockey team in 2000, (Minnesota Wild), they had a Zam- boni machine parade. There were more than a dozen Zamboni machines involved in the parade, which garnered national media attention.

amateur status of all participants.

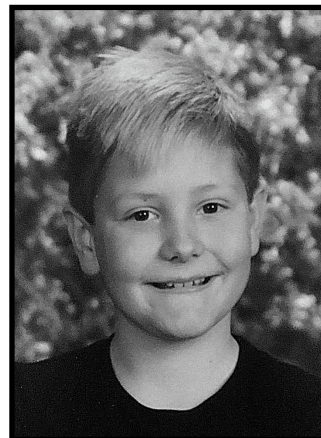
The North Stars are active in the community as well as on the ice. They provided over 600 hours of volunteer contributions to communities, organizations and schools in the area.

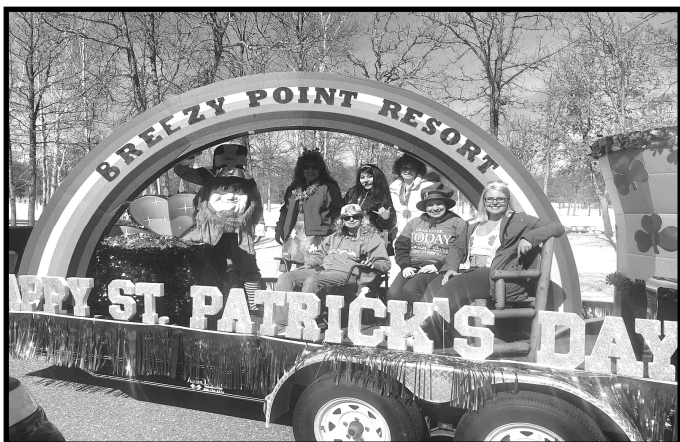

These three properties are the only timeshare facilities at Breezy Point that have been awarded these designations.

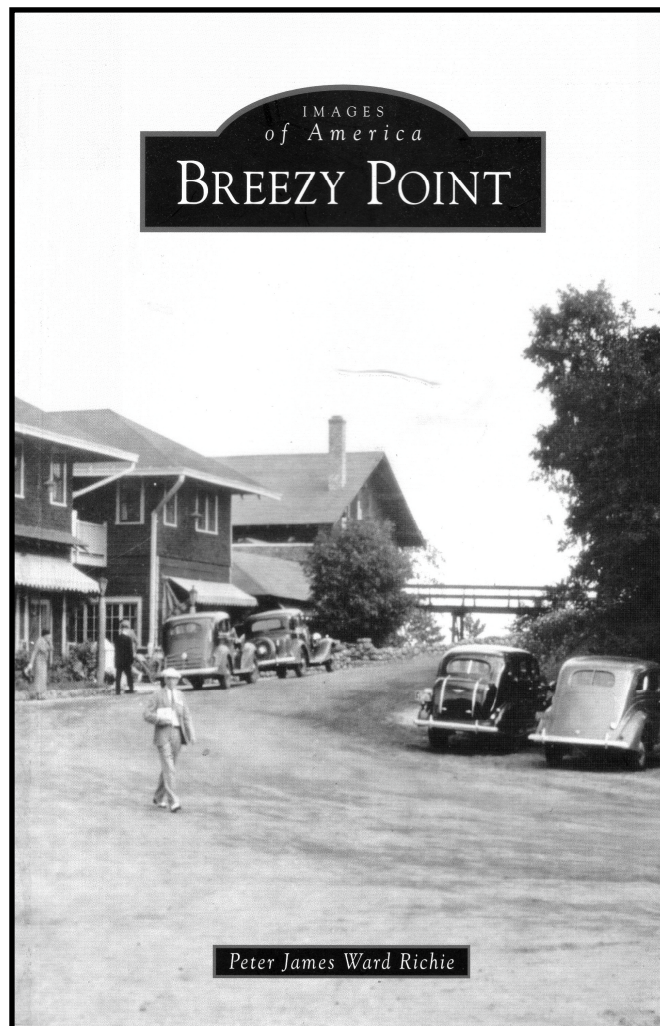

Reliving Memories

The following is the recent account of Myleene Leren Sohaei who worked at the Resort in 1958.

This past summer my husband and I were guests at Breezy Point Resort. I was a waitress there during the summer of 1958.

We met Bob Spizzo, owner of the resort, who was most kind in telling us all about the dramatic changes at the resort over the recent years and invited us to return any time.

We purchased from the Resort Gift Shop the

book, *Images of America Breezy Point* and found a photo of my friend and me.

After high school we answered a newspaper ad landed jobs at the Resort to earn money for college. It was our first time away from home and living on our own.

Our families drove us there from La Crosse, WI, and discovered our residence happened what was called a “converted horse barn”. There were wooden floors, and the beds were lined up in a row. My aunt took one look from the screen door and refused to go inside.

We worked hard that summer, but we made new friends, enjoyed many moments of laughter and good times. We didn’t earn much in salary, perhaps fifty cents an hour. However, our tips brought us close to the

\$1,000 mark by the end of the summer.

None of us had a car, so we would hitch hike for short distances – like into Brainerd.

I recall our Maître d’ (and boss) had a soft spot in his heart for “his kids”.

Some were caught taking melons from the kitchen for a beach party. He could have fired them but instead he acknowledged that he knew what they had done and forgave them. After that, if we wanted melons, we asked for them.

Included in our jobs was talent show entertainment. We had a beauty contest and were told that participation may increase our tips.

Some of the college bound kids were quite talented. One gal taught us many of the tunes from “South Pacific”. I still remember our ver-

sion of “I’m Gonna Wash That Man Right Outa My Hair”.

We had kitchen and dining room duties. We carried heavy trays, sometimes having to lift them above our head as we made our way through the dining room. I remember slipping in the kitchen. There went several meals. The chef and maître d’ were angry, but not for long.

We would regularly serve banquets. One of the bus boys tripped and fell. He was carrying a tub of dirty dishes and leftover food to the kitchen. His fall caused much of his tub to land on or near some of the guests. Not a pretty picture, but the bus boy remained on staff. Perhaps he was one of the talented entertainers!

So these are my memories of the summer of 1958.

Tiny Ticks, Big Problem

Tiny ticks are becoming a big problem. A growing number of people are getting sick from diseases carried by the black-legged tick, commonly known as a deer tick.

Lyme disease is the most common tick-borne illness in Minnesota and Wisconsin so that’s the one everyone thinks about first, says Dr. Kevin Stephan, an Essential Health infectious disease specialist. But ticks also spread anaplasmosis, ehrlichiosis and babesiosis, a parasite that infects red blood cells.

Adult deer ticks are tiny – about the size of a sesame seed. That’s why many people don’t realize they’ve been bitten until they have symptoms.

Prevention is key, says Dr. Stephan, who reminds you to do a thorough check of your body after being outdoors.

Your risk is greatest from late spring through mid-summer, when ticks are most active. Ticks are active again in the fall. Treat your skin with a repellent that includes DEET and your clothing with permethrin, which is available at sporting goods stores, he advises.

Dr. Stephan uses four black sesame seeds to demonstrate the size of deer ticks.

Tick-borne illnesses can range from mild to severe. Fever often brings people to the doctor. Other symptoms feel like the flu, such as severe body aches and headaches.

All four tick-borne diseases are easily treated, Dr. Stephan says, but Lyme disease can have lasting effects if it’s not caught early.
